Family Promise of St. Tammany provides homeless children and their families with safe and comfortable shelter, meals and compassionate support.

Local congregations throughout St. Tammany Parish host up to five families (14 people) at a time on a weekly rotating schedule.

Host congregation volunteers may share meals and fellowship with families, play with a tutor the children, and act as overnight hosts.

During the day, families in the program receive social services and job counseling as well as casework assistance at the Family Promise Day Center located on the Safe Haven campus.

Robert's Rules of Order: Making a Motion

A member makes a motion to propose an action or make a decision by saying, "I move to...". Another member must second the motion by saying, "I second the motion." Once someone seconds the motion, the group votes on the motion. It passes by a majority vote or a quorum depending on the rules in the bylaws.

Mindful Coloring asks us to focus on how we choose to apply color in a design to bring our awareness to the present moment. This process is similar to meditation, when we let go of any thoughts about tomorrow or yesterday, or what we are going to do when we finish. There are several benefits of mindful coloring, which include:

- it relaxes your brain and improves brain function
- induces meditative state
- improves motor skills
- improves sleep
- improves focus
- reduces anxiety and relieves stress.
